RECOVERY trial DMC report

Thank you for your email with the details of recruitment to the influenza and community acquired pneumonia comparisons since our last meeting, asking if the DMC should meet about now to review the data.

Patients recruited since last DMC data-cut on 18/3/2024

Influenza - Baloxavir: 24 more (277 in total in this comparison)

Influenza - Oseltamivir: 5 more (54 in total)

Influenza - Dexamethasone: 14 more (87 in total)

Community Acquired Pneumonia - dexamethasone: 181 more (214 in total).

In reply to your question, given the small number of additional cases since the last DMC review, I see no need to prepare a full report or convene a meeting of the DMC. Instead, I suggest the DMC meets in about three months time. That review can be brought forward if there is a surge in recruitment.
